The Cairns woodlot dedication was held on Arbor Day, May 6, 1949. Gertrude Cairns sold the 34-acre lot to the Village of Ellsworth at a fraction of the cost with the guarantee of complete protection of the woods.

According to the May 5, 1949 Pierce County Herald, "Miss Cairns, when a child, liked to pick wildflowers and watch the birds. As the village grew, she saw the wooded areas being turned into fields, the flowers disappearing, and the birds pushed back into wilder areas." She was noted as saying "I just want to save one place where children can pick wildflowers and the woods can be kept in their natural state."

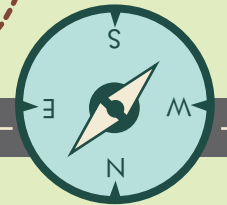
